via the MSTC portal (Metal Scrap Trade Corporation Limited), in accordance with all prescribed procedures, vide Auction Reference No. MSTC/NRO/Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences/ 1/ South West Delhi/ 25-26/ 13914. The reserve price for the said items was fixed at Rs. 30,452/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Two Only) as per official records.

Following a competitive bidding process, M/s. Greensense Waste Recycling Management Private Limited emerged as the highest bidder, quoting a final amount of Rs. 6,25,102/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Twenty-Five Thousand One Hundred and Two Only).

Upon completion of all procedural formalities, the aforesaid vendor shall be authorized to collect the item lot from the College premises and dispose of the items, as per the Government of India's laid-down guidelines. The proceeds from the auction shall be credited in the Delhi Government Grant Account as per the financial norms.

**(2) Consideration of proposals for various projects of PwD (Civil and Electrical) for onward submission to DHE for Administrative approval and Expenditure Sanction.**

**(A) Proposal for Urgent repair of main gate and laying of damaged sewer pipeline at main gate of Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences, during the financial year 2025-26.**

The members of the Governing Body noted that the College had repeatedly requested the PWD (Civil) to undertake urgent repair work at the main gate of the college, particularly:

- Repair of the main gate structure, and
- Replacement of the damaged sewer pipeline, vide letters dated 28/02/2025, and 08/04/2025.

In response, the Executive Engineer, PWD (Civil), vide letter dated 10/06/2025 (received on 13/06/2025), submitted a detailed proposal amounting to ₹25,79,200/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Lakhs Seventy-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Only) for the undertaking the **Urgent repair of main gate and laying of damaged sewer pipeline at main gate of Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences, during the financial year 2025-26.**

The members further noted the critical and urgent nature of the repair work due to:

- A prior incident where one of the iron gates suddenly collapsed, posing a major safety risk—although no injury occurred.
- The stone cladding/tiles on the gate pillars are detaching and falling, creating a serious hazard to staff, students, and visitors.

These issues necessitate immediate intervention to prevent further structural damage

*After due consideration and in light of these safety concerns, the members of the Governing Body unanimously approved the proposal of ₹25,79,200/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Lakhs Seventy-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Only) for the Urgent repair of main gate and laying of damaged sewer pipeline at main gate of Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences to be executed by the PWD (Civil) on a priority basis during the year 2025-26.*

- (B) **Proposal for ARMO EI & Fans, Pumps, F/F & F/A, Compound Light, DG Set, Intercom, PA System etc. at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences during Financial Year 2025-26**

The members of the Governing Body noted that, vide letter No. BCAS/2024/PWD Elect./2025/2178 dated 28.02.2025, the College had requested the PWD (Electrical) for a proposal for Annual Repair, Maintenance and Operation (ARMO) of various electrical installations and systems including Electrical Installations (EI) & Fans, Pumps, Fire Fighting (F/F) & Fire Alarm (F/A) systems, Compound Lighting, DG Set, Intercom, Public Address (PA) System, etc. at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences.

In response, vide letter dated 31/05/2025 (received on 04/06/2025), the Executive Engineer, PWD (Electrical), submitted a proposal amounting to **₹48,72,224/- (Rupees Forty-Eight Lakhs Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Four Only)** for ARMO of the aforementioned systems for a period of **12 months** for the financial year **2025-26**.

*After due consideration, the members of the Governing Body approved the proposal of ₹48,72,224/- (Rupees Forty-Eight Lakhs Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Four Only) for the ARMO EI & Fans, Pumps, F/F & F/A, Compound Light, DG Set, Intercom, PA System etc. at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences for a period of 12 months to be executed by the PWD (Electrical) on a priority basis during Financial Year 2025-26.*

- (C) **Proposal for A/R & M/O for Civil Work at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences during the year 2025-26.**

The members of the Governing Body noted that the College had requested the PWD (Civil) to submit a proposal for the Annual Repair and Maintenance (A/R & M/O) of civil works at the College.

In response, vide letter dated 13/06/2025 (received on 16/06/2025), the Executive Engineer, PWD (Civil), has submitted a proposal amounting to **₹29,56,400/- (Rupees Twenty-Nine Lakhs Fifty-Six Thousand and Four Hundred Only)** for carrying out A/R

*After due consideration, the members of the Governing Body approved the proposal for ₹29,56,400/- (Rupees Twenty-Nine Lakhs Fifty-Six Thousand and Four Hundred Only) for Annual Repair and Maintenance of civil works at the Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences, to be executed by the PWD (Civil) on a priority basis during the financial year 2025–26.*

### (D) **Construction of Six porta Cabins at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences**

The members of the Governing Body noted the urgent need for additional classrooms and lecture rooms in view of the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) and the introduction of the fourth academic year under UGCF structure. The proposed porta cabins are aimed to address this requirement, ensuring the availability of sufficient space for the smooth conduct of classes. The Porta cabins are considered the most suitable solution, as they can be constructed in a shorter time frame and in a comparatively lower budget, as compared to construction of permanent structures.

In its 105th meeting, the Governing Body had earlier approved a proposal for the construction of eight porta cabins amounting to ₹96,96,900/- (Rupees Seventy-Five Lakhs Nineteen Thousand Only) to be executed by the PWD (Civil). However, keeping in view the urgency of requirements and the need for financial prudence, it was decided to proceed, initially, with the construction of six porta cabins to evaluate their effectiveness and comfort.

Accordingly, vide Letter No. DB23(5)/SWBMD/PWD/2025-26/641 dated 19/06/2025, the Executive Engineer (Civil), PWD, has forwarded a proposal amounting to **₹75,19,000/- (Rupees Seventy-Five Lakhs Nineteen Thousand Only)** for the construction of **six porta cabins** at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences.

**(E) Proposal for Providing and Replacement of Fire Fighting System at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences.**

The members of the Governing Body noted that the College had repeatedly informed the PWD (Electrical) about the deteriorating condition of the fire fighting system in the campus. Recently, vide letter No. BCAS/2024/1(2) PWD/Elect./2025/33 dated 08.04.2025, the College once again requested the PWD to provide a new fire fighting system and to replace the existing outdated and non-functional units.

In response, vide letter dated 30/05/2025 (received on 04/06/2025), the Executive Engineer, PWD (Electrical), submitted a proposal amounting to ₹28,85,740/- (Rupees Twenty-Eight Lakhs Eighty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Only) for the provision of a new fire fighting system and replacement of the outdated, non-functional fire fighting infrastructure at Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences.

After due deliberation, the members of the Governing Body approved the proposal of ₹28,85,740/- (Rupees Twenty-Eight Lakhs Eighty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Only) for providing a new fire fighting system and replacing the old non-functional systems at the Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences. The work shall be executed by the PWD (Electrical) on a priority basis during the financial year 2025–26, in order to ensure the safety of life and property and to avoid any incident or unforeseen emergency.

Summarily, in order of priority, the following project/work proposals submitted by PWD (Civil) and PWD (Electrical), were reviewed and approved by the Governing Body, to be undertaken on an urgent basis to ensure the smooth functioning of the College during the financial year 2025–26.

### 4) Request for permission to engage Sports Coaches for the Various sports / Value Addition Courses (VAC) in Sports for Undergraduate students during the session 2025-2025

The member of the GB noted that Vide email dated 03/06/2025 of the Director, Physical Education & Sports, Delhi University Sports Council, University of Delhi, it was informed that vide letter No. CB.II/Status/Phy.Edu Coaches/2024/70 dated 20/02/2024 and pursuant to the discussion held on 06/02/2024 with the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi, and other University Officials, the colleges were encouraged to promote the physical activity and overall well-being of the students by facilitating participation in sports and physical education programs beyond the classroom. During the course of the discussion, it was agreed, in principle, that feasibility be explored by the Colleges/Institutions to engage Coaches on the remuneration adopted by the Delhi University Sports Council (DUSC) as per the requirement for the Various sports/ Value Addition Courses (VAC) in sports for Undergraduate students.

Accordingly, the approval of the University was conveyed to the Colleges/ Institutions to hire the Coaches on a need basis for different sports for which remuneration shall be paid @ Rupees 1500/- per day inclusive of travel expenditure.

Eligibility criteria for Sports Coaches were also specified as under:

#### Essential:

1. Bachelor's/Master's degree in Physical Education
2. Diploma in Coaching from NIS, Patiala or an equivalent qualification from recognized University/Institution
