

## Resolution of Emergency Staff Council Meeting

held on March 21, 2013

An emergent staff council meeting was held on March 21, 2013 at 12.30 pm. in the conference room with reference to the restructuring of the courses in University of Delhi for the upcoming four year degree courses. After the discussions and deliberations, the following resolution was adopted:

1. The college was started in the year 1995 with the aim to cater to specialized applied science courses. The college has adequate infrastructure and very well equipped laboratories worth crores of rupees to run these courses. The placement status of our honours courses is extremely commendable. Our students are doing extremely well and are placed in national and multinational companies.
2. In order to maintain the identity of the college in Applied Sciences stream, all the Honours courses being run at present in the college i.e. **B.Sc. (Hons) in Biomedical Sciences, Instrumentation, Electronics, Food Technology, Polymer Science, Computer Science, Physics and Microbiology should be upgraded to the proposed four year programme.**
3. It is humbly submitted that option of DC-II courses could be taken from existing allied departments of the college.
4. The faculty members who have been/may be adversely affected by the introduction of the semester system and further by the proposed four year degree programme may be academically rehabilitated by introduction of new courses in the college.
