

## **Important Instructions – OBE December 2020**

All the students (regular and ex-students), who are going to appear in semester theory examinations, December 2020 in OBE mode are requested to note the following:

1. All the students are required to read all the instructions very carefully which are given in the OBE Guidelines given by the University in the Notification dated 18.11.2020. A copy of the notification is available on the official website of the University of Delhi and also on the website of the college i.e. <http://bcas.du.ac.in> in the “Examinations” Tab available under the “Students Corner” menu.
2. Registration on OBE portal i.e. <https://obe.uod.ac.in> is mandatory for appearing in the semester theory open book examination December 2020.
3. All students should write University Examination Roll Number and **NOT THE COLLEGE ROLL NUMBER** on the answer sheet.
4. For all the students admitted in the CBCS mode in the year 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, or admitted in CBCS (LOCF) Mode in the year 2019, there are three types of date-sheets for different category of papers. One for Core/DSE/SEC papers, second for Generic Elective papers and third for AECC papers.
5. All students have to follow the date-sheet for theory papers as per the year of their admission in the college. All details, for which category of students the date-sheet is applicable, has been mentioned on the very first page of every date-sheet.
6. All students have to follow the schedule of papers (date and timings) as given on the first page of every date-sheet.
7. For Generic Elective Paper there will be two dates of examination in the date-sheet, one for I semester and other for III semester. Students have to appear in the examination on the date of exam as per their semester of GE paper. It is quite possible that the link for downloading the question paper and uploading the answer sheet will be available on the OBE portal on both dates, but students have to appear in the examination as per the date-sheet according to their semester of GE paper.
8. For DSE (Discipline Specific Elective) papers there will be two dates of examination in the date-sheet one for DSE-1 and the other for DSE-2. In some departments, both DSE papers may be mentioned on both dates of examinations. In such departments, where both DSE papers are mentioned on both dates, students have to appear in the examinations of the paper in alphabetical order off the title of their both DSE papers. It is quite possible that the link of downloading the question paper and uploading the answer sheet, will be available on both dates, but students have to appear in the paper as per the alphabetical order of the title of their DSE papers.
