Each Second Year student of 2021-2022 batch has to select one Generic Elective (GE-III) Paper in their upcoming III semester through the link available on the college website (Student Corner>Form>GE3Sem Form). Kindly go through the [GE Norms](#) available there before filling the GE preferences. GE preferences have to be filled using the [BCAS Student App](#). Kindly go through the [tutorial](#) to know the process to fill the GE Form. Some courses are having fixed GE, unless surrendered by the student in writing. As required for their higher studies.

In case of result on the CGPA basis, you are required to multiply the result by a factor of 9.5 to fill the result in percentage. For students whose result is yet not declared by the University, for whatever reasons) may submit the result of last annual examination passed with a penalty of 10%.● No change will be allowed after the due date and time notified on the form.● Keep track on the college website regarding your responses recorded by the system. If your response on the website is coming blank/ different, immediately contact your Teacher in Charge with a proof of your CNF no.● In case of false information or/and duplicate entry of the subject, the form is likely to be rejected. You may not get your preferred GE option.● The college reserves the right to allot the required GE option of its own.
